



De Stroom ‘Living together, learning together’

‘De Stroom’ is a small primary school where children between the ages of 2 to 13 from all nationalities come together for education. Our school has about 100 pupils divided over two units. Each unit consists of two groups of 25 pupils with several teachers devoted to each group.

‘De Stroom’ is part of a “kindcentrum”. Within this kindcentrum we tightly work together with LeLa: a day care, kindergarten and after-school childcare. To ensure efficiency within the kindcentrum, all parties involved work together intensively.

During the day, every single pupil gets instructions on a different level to make sure they are able to learn in their own pace. This more personal way of teaching enables us teachers to meet every child’s need with a fitting offer: some children need to be challenged and some need more support.

Learning together and learning from each other is very important to us. Because we value this so much, we stimulate the pupils to work together throughout different projects. During these projects ‘De Stroom’ works with different companies in the area to explore and learn together. We are a connected Brainportschool.

A school day begins with classes in mathematics and language. Modern devices like chromebooks allow the children to give form to their own learning. The lessons in ‘project based learning’ start after lunch. These projects are based on the school’s curriculum and are meant to accelerate learning. The projects offer the children the opportunity to learn in a practical way and stay tuned to the latest trends.



Musical and physical education are also part of a school day to stimulate creativity and arts. Physical education classes are taught by our sports teacher and the classes dedicated to the arts are given form and assisted by a team of teachers.

The pupils who require extra lessons in the Dutch language get remedial teaching.

Our goal is to create an environment where children are eager to learn and seen as individuals, but most importantly: a place where children can be the best version of themselves.
